Ben Kitchen (dream cast: Daniel Radcliffe) wears the clothes his mum buys him for his birthday. He's had the same haircut for twenty years. His house is full of tiny

soldiers from the ancient world and he knows more about Roman warfare than any grown man should. His ambitions are so tiny as to be almost non-existent. Ben likes his new neighbour; it's refreshing to meet another person who isn't a slave to fashion...



Nerys Thomas (dream cast: Michaela Cole) is a headstrong young woman who knows life is too short to hang about. She has firm goals in life and devotes all her energy to

achieving them. Number one amongst those goals is finding and ensnaring the perfect man. Nerys doesn't put up with any nonsense from her new neighbour and in fact feels that it is her right – her duty – to get Clovenhoof to sort his act out: get a job, get a woman and put on some underpants.

Archangel

Michael (dream cast: Neil Patrick Harris) has the looks of a Hollywood icon and the sartorial



elegance of a supermodel. He glides through a world that is either perfect or needs to be perfect. He will intercede in every one of Clovenhoof's misadventures, not only to impress his Heavenly superiors but also to prove that he is and always has been better than Lucifer...
